

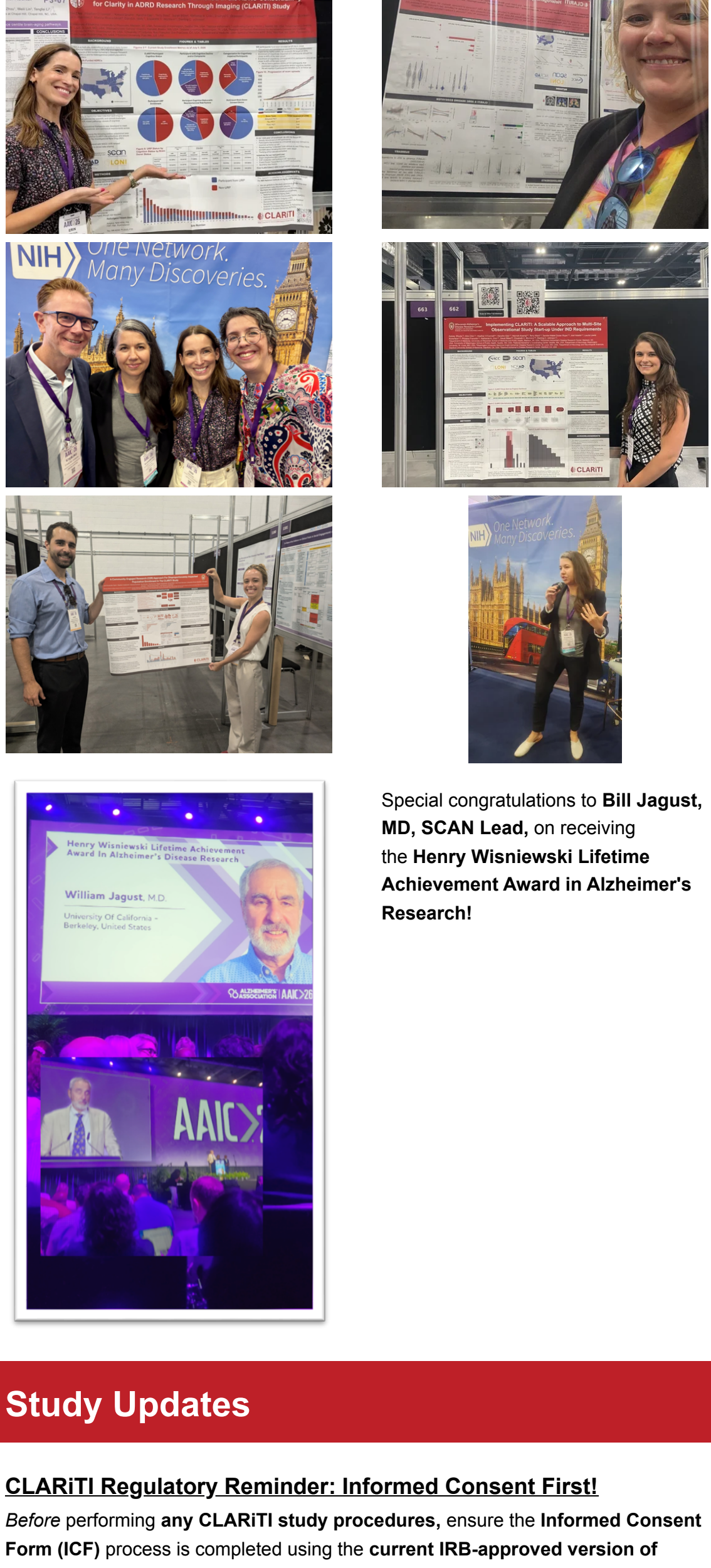

Study Updates

CLARITI Regulatory Reminder: Informed Consent First!

Before performing any CLARITI study procedures, ensure the **Informed Consent Form (ICF)** process is completed using the **current IRB-approved version of CLARITI consent form**.

Checklist:

- **Verify** the latest IRB-approved CLARITI ICF in **ClinSphere® eReview Manager**
- **Share** the approved version with all staff responsible for obtaining informed consent.
- **Confirm** you are using the current version before consenting a participant.
- **Obtain** the participant's or Legally Authorized Representative (LAR)'s signature and date **before any study- specific procedures begin**.

Remember: The informed consent process is the first step in protecting participants and ensuring study compliance! Thank you.

WCG IRB Portal Migration Update

Attention CLARITI Study Sites:

Please be informed that the **WCG IRB Portal (Connexus)** is no longer available, as it has been migrated to **ClinSphere® eReview Manager**. This migration is part of the ongoing efforts to enhance study management and streamline review processes.

What You Need to Do:

- **Personnel who previously accessed WCG Connexus:** Please review the **eReview Manager Data Migration FAQ** carefully. It includes step-by-step instructions for accessing the new **ClinSphere® eReview Manager** portal.

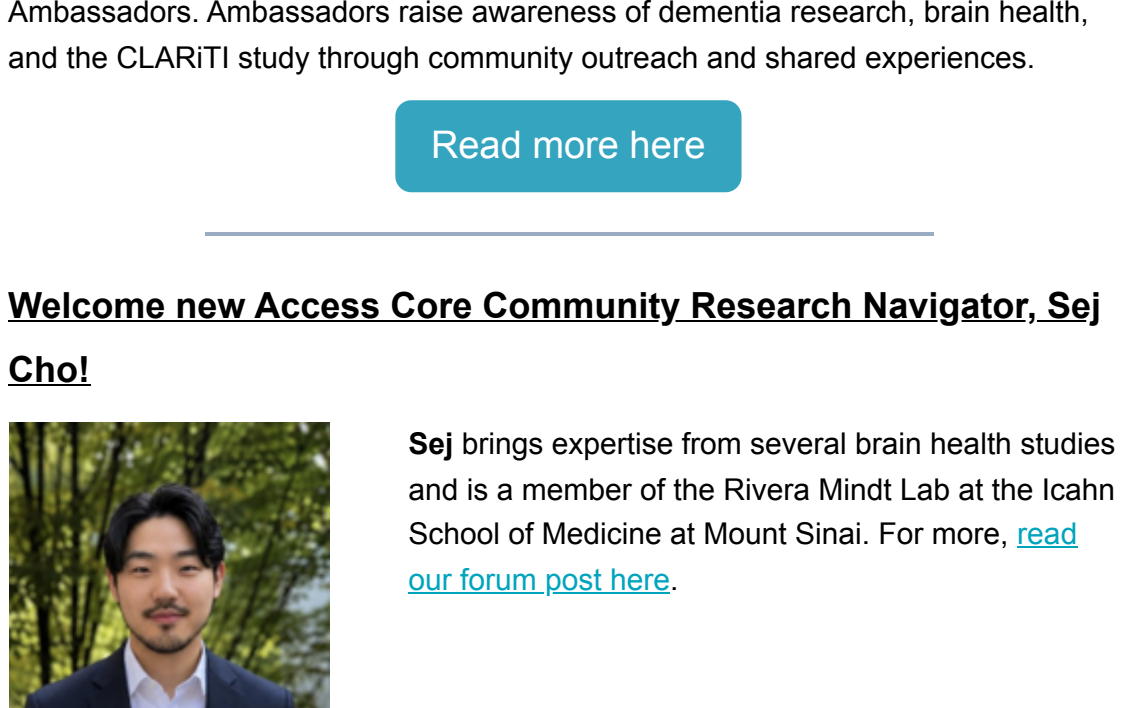

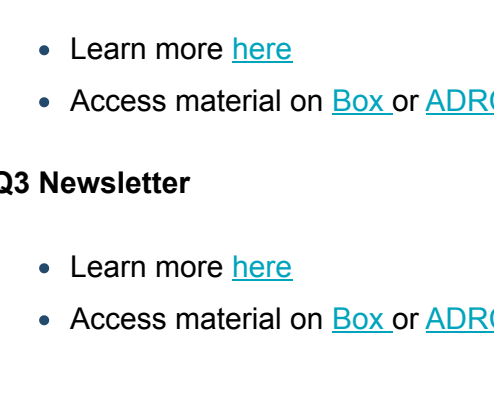

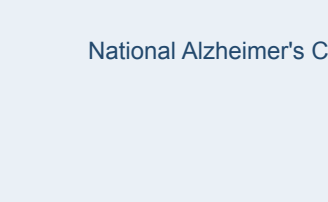
Support Community Engagement: Nominate a CLARITI Ambassador
