



NIA/ADEAR Update

AD Genetics Study

- **Recruitment status:** 661 approved pedigrees/families; 442 pedigrees with at least one sample at NCRAD; 1,885 total samples to NCRAD.
- NAPS article: Short article on the Genetics Study to be distributed via the North American Precis Syndicat – nationwide network of 10,000 newspapers (primarily small community daily or weekly newspapers) and 1,000+ African American and Hispanic community newspapers. Estimated to generate about 100-400 local article placements.
- Newsletter: NIA/ADEAR staff are working on a second issue of the Genetics Study newsletter, which goes twice a year to participating families. Should be ready for distribution by early November.
- Award: The Washington DC Chapter of the International Association of Business Communicators awarded the AD Genetics Study Tool Kit a "Silver Inkwell" award for high quality communications work.
