- Pursue opportunities to educate physicians on Association services

- Builds on research in residential facilities to develop practice recommendations

 - 2. Pain Management
 - 3. Social Engagement
- Seek endorsement of practice recommendations from industry, professionals, policy leaders and consumer advocates
