- Three, four or five year awards
- Up to \$200,000 a year

**Now includes funds particularly for career awards targeting Alzheimer's research.**

# LOAN REPAYMENT

- Programs for clinical research, health disparities, disadvantaged researchers, pediatric research
- Repays parts of educational loans of health professionals who agree to conduct relevant research for at least two years at 50% effort or greater

# LOAN REPAYMENT (contd.)

- Pays up to \$35,000 annually plus applicable federal taxes.
- Debt must be at least 20% of institutional base salary at time of award.
- Programs accepting applications until December 1, 2007
