# Three b-BSSR Categories

## 1. Behavioral and Social Processes

*(e.g., learning, social cognition, group processes, migration patterns)*

## 2. Biopsychosocial Research

*(Also known as biobehavioral or biosocial research)*

## 3. Methodology and measurement

*(e.g., data collection, modeling, research design)*


