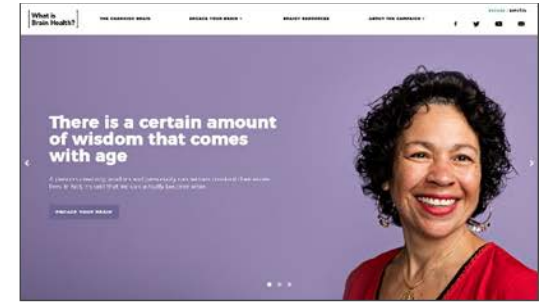

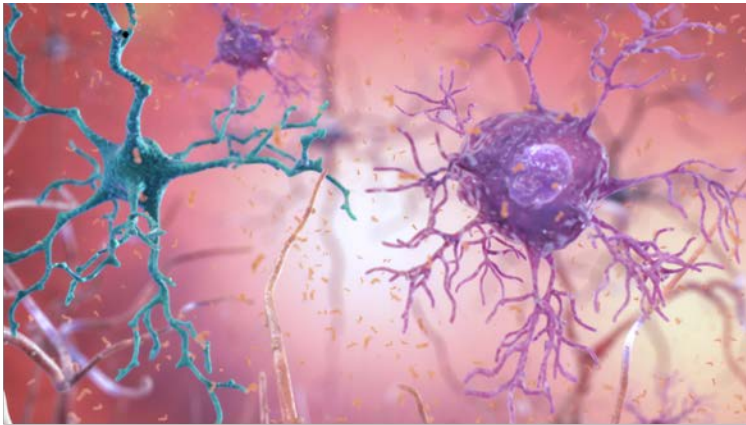
Alzheimers.gov

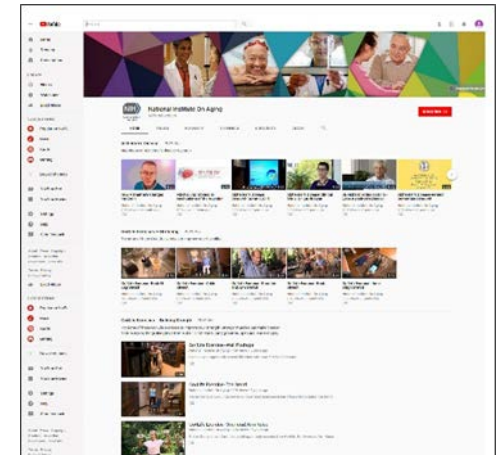
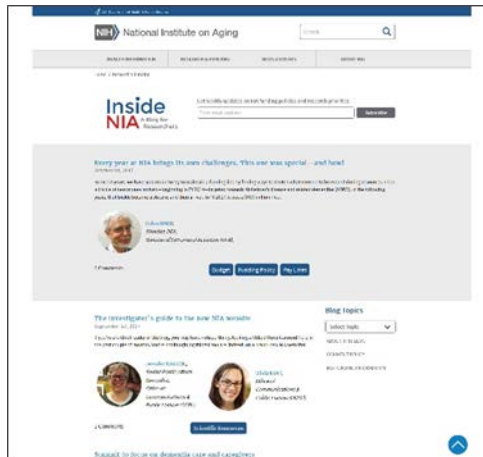
