# New NACC ID Process – Key Points

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- Crucial step in becoming more multimodal
- NACC ID assigned at the time of consent
- Benefits:
  - Supports multimodal data collection, integration, and sharing
  - Data types can be submitted to NACC in any order
  - Supports tracking subjects who change ADRCs
  - Uses minimal information already collected by Centers
- Planning to rollout alongside the UDSv4 transition

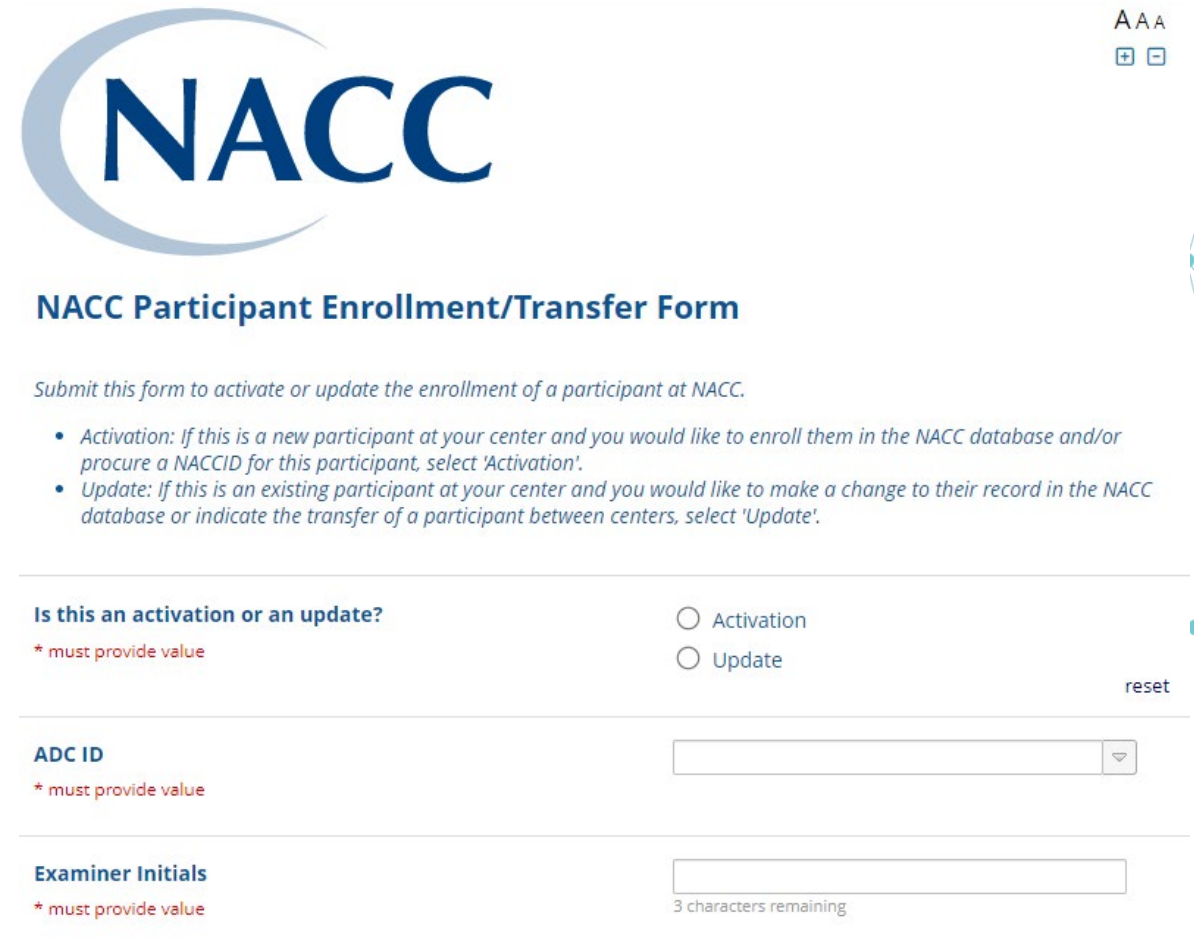
# New Form – NACC Participant Enrollment/Transfer Form

- Minimum Initial Data Collection

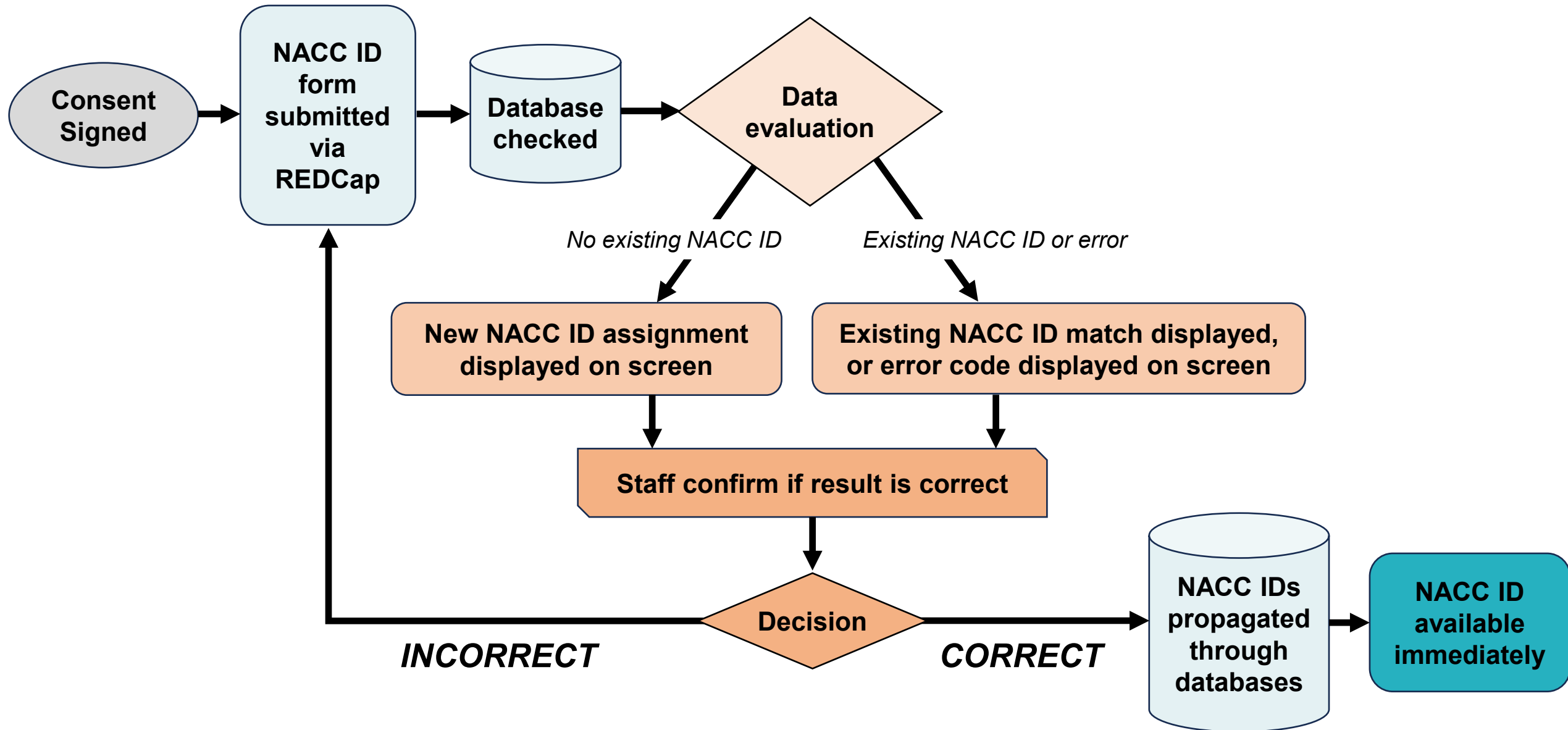
- ADC ID
- Examiner Initials
- PT ID
- NIA GUID? (yes/no)
- Existing NACC id? (yes/no)

- Supports Updates and Transfers

- Update (yes/no)
- Enrolled at a previous center? (yes/no)

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# Considerations for Clinical Staff

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1. Change in workflow
2. Done right after consent
3. May entail minimal demographic data is collected
4. Requires validating a participant has (or has not) been a participant at another ADRC



# Considerations for Data Managers

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1. Change in workflow
2. Must be uploaded quickly and in advance of ALL other data modalities (SCAN, NCRAD, etc.)
3. NACC ID is returned immediately with accompanying email
4. Is independent on visit completion metrics, won't impact performance
5. Adds another ID to track for persistence

# Considerations for Participants

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1. Extra time in intake/consent process
2. Added time is really the only burden at intake
3. May ask some questions twice e.g. sex, race [Again, contingent on things that are being collected]
4. Needs to be considered upon transfer to a new Center

# Next Steps

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1. Watch for communications from NACC with timing updates
2. Participate in the NACC ID trial to provide feedback
3. Onboarding documentation, training and troubleshooting documentation will be available
