

- Collaboration with the Alzheimer's Association
- 10 awards (up from 2!)
- Funding Twice as much funding \$135K direct costs per award
- Eligibility open to any early career investigators that are affiliated with an ADRC
- Any area of research related to AD/ADRD is eligible; there
 is no requirement to use NACC data (although it is
 welcome!)

- Increase the odds of successful applications
- Provide additional value to all applicants
- Support a diverse pool of applicants


