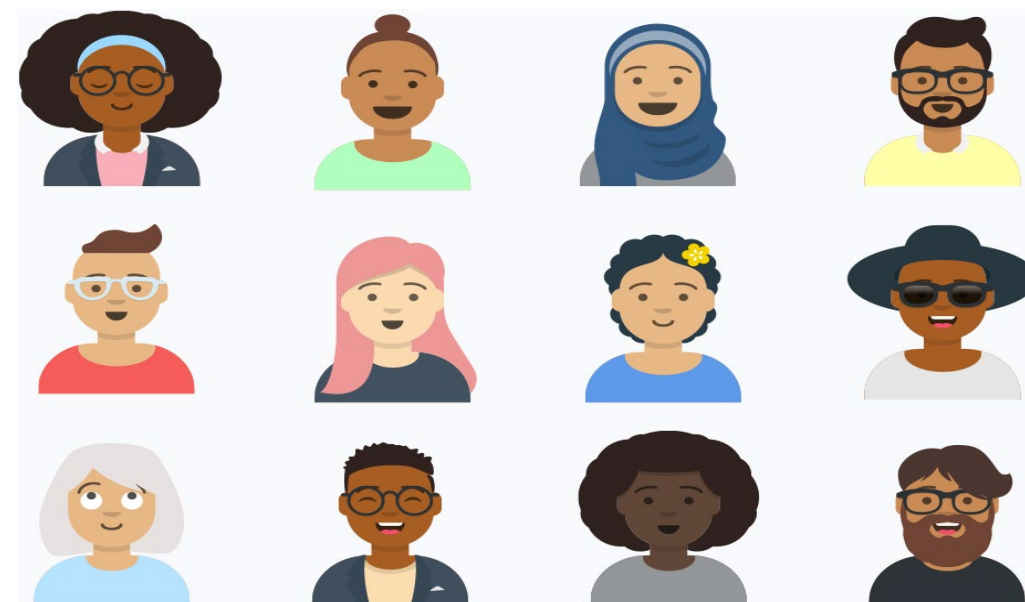

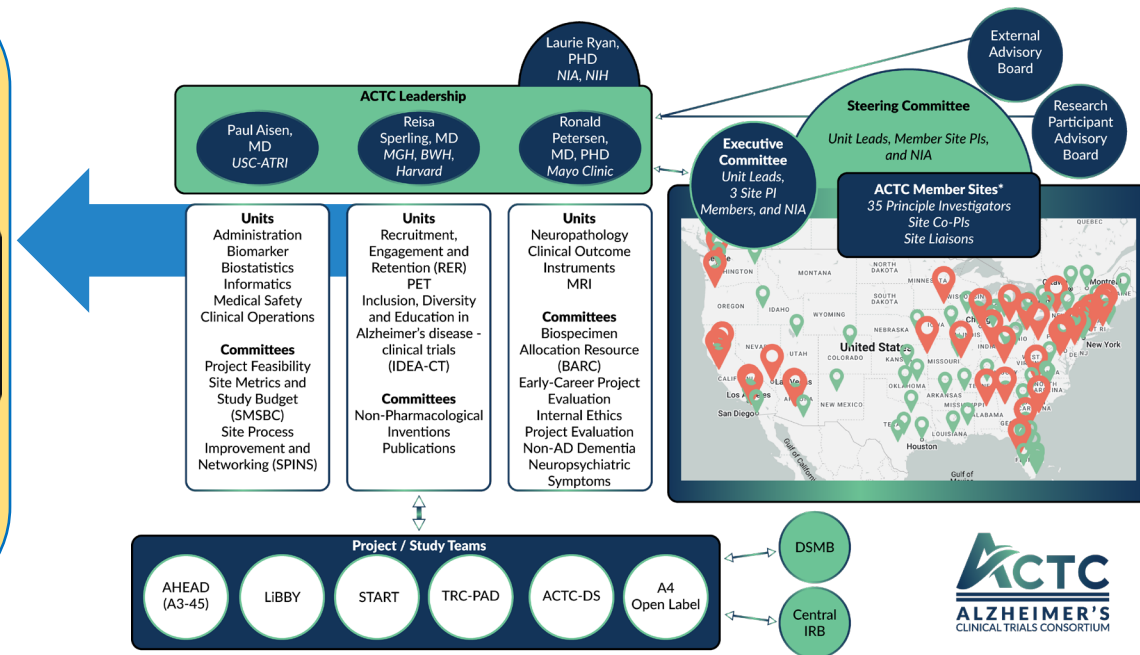
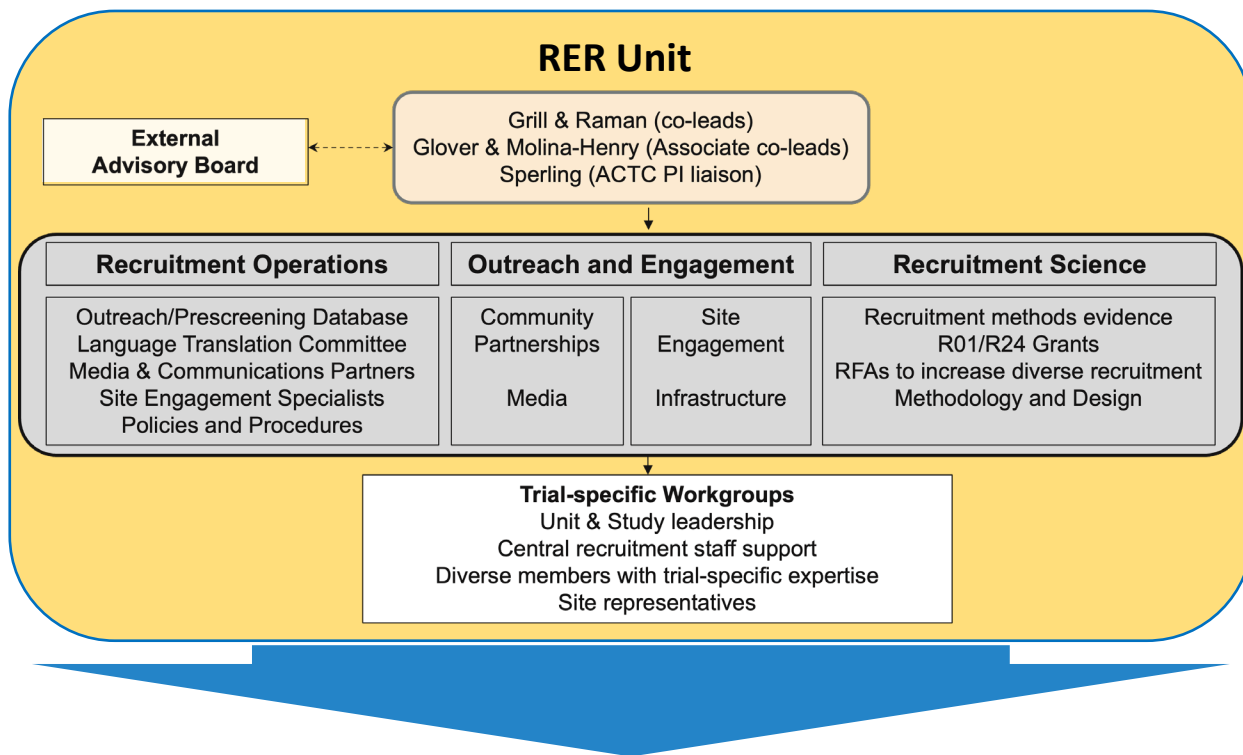

- Every ACTC Steering Committee site is being funded to have 12 cal months effort for a **Community Engagement Specialist (CES)**.
- The CES is responsible for identifying, building, and maintaining relationships within local communities that will serve as sources of study recruitment and participant retention.
- Sites are expected to have specific underrepresented communities of emphasis, for which trial enrollment goals will be set.
- These resources and the effort they support are a logical opportunity for synergy between ACTC and ADRCs, particularly through ORE Cores.

ADRC Consortium for Clarity in ADRD Research Through Imaging (CLARiTI)

U01 mPIs: Dickerson, Foroud, Johnson*, Kukull, Mormino*, Okonkwo, Rabinovici, Rivera Mindt, & Wolk *Contact mPIs

CLARiTI Vision: Empower & engage ppl from *all* communities to prevent or effectively treat the multiple intersecting causes of ADRD cognitive impairment

DESIGN:

- **Under-included populations for generalizable science: $\geq 25\%$**
- Involves *all* ADRCs ($N=2,000$ Clinical Core participants; 60% impaired, 40% unimpaired w/ risk factors)
- *Heterogeneity* is welcome: Syndromes/pathologies - Multi-Etiology Dementia

Approach

Culturally-informed, community-engaged research (CER) methods

Local Support (“Boots on the Ground”)

- **Community Research Liaison (CRL)**
 - One 100% FTE CRL at site for CLARiTI
 - Serves as link bet. community & study site
 - Promotes inclusion/engagement of under-included pop’s* in neuroimaging

Community Support

- Flexible annual \$ (*up to \$10K*; e.g., support/partnership w/ community org’s; outreach/engagement events)

Central Support (CER Digital Outreach/Engagement)

- National Community-Science Partnership Board (CSPB)
- Community Research Navigators ($N \simeq 5$)
- Training of CLARiTI staff & PIs/Co-Is in cultural competence and CER
- Culturally-informed CER based digital outreach campaign & inclusion/engagement materials
