NACC and the REC Steering Committee are partnering again this year to identify and match early career investigators with mentors:


- Matches are based on research expertise and background

Expectations of Mentors and Mentees:

- Meet at least twice between November 15, 2024, and January 8, 2025
- Participate in program evaluations:
 - Mid-Program Check-In Survey (Dec 2024-Jan 2025)
 - End of Program Evaluation Survey (February 2026)
 - Follow-up Survey (one year later)

November 8, 2024	 Respond to survey from NACC: Sign up to become a Mentor (new) Confirm participation (returning Mentors)
November 8, 2024	Applicants submit Letter of Intent (LOI) and sign up for a Mentor
November 22, 2024, to January 15, 2025	Mentors and Mentees are matched and meet to review aims and proposal
January 16, 2025	Applications due
January 17 to February 15, 2025	Respond to Mentor/Mentee Survey
August-September 2025	Respond to 6-month Mentee Survey
